



Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19) Club Policy Effective 11 January 2022

This Club Policy is effective from 11 January 2022 and replaces the policy in place since 11 March 2021.

This follows from World Health Organisation, Australian Government and SA Government directives and advice. The committee has decided to revise & reissue this Club Policy to allow for the current changes in restrictions arising from the impact of Omicron.

Australian Government Department Of Health & SA Government Health directives – It is expected that at club runs / events, all participants will follow the directives outlined in the following:

Event participants should take the time to make themselves familiar with the information outlined on these websites, which includes but is not limited to the need for good hygiene, appropriate social distancing & complying with activity restrictions. It is recommended that all participants bring their own sanitiser, hand wipes and face masks.

As the websites are used as a guide and are subject to change, it is the club members, guests and Come & Try participants responsibility to familiarize themselves with the latest COVID directives before attending any club run / event.

We are an understanding and inclusive car club and we respect all participants for taking their own personal COVID-19 precautions. This may mean that participants will remain separate from other attendees, may elect to not have physical contact &/or may attend a club run but not the following lunch or dinner etc.

Attendance at Club Runs / Events – It is a participant's explicit choice to attend a club run / event and they should be fully aware of the health risks from doing so.

Attendance Restrictions at Club Runs / Events – It is a strict requirement that any club member, guest or Come & Try participant **MUST NOT ATTEND** any club event if they:

- are subject to testing, isolating &/or quarantine restrictions
- are feeling unwell or showing any symptoms which may indicate Coronavirus, Influenza or a common cold.

Attendance at Motorsport Events – This policy applies equally to club members, guests and Come & Try participants attending Motorsport Events.

Attendance at non-MX-5 Club Hosted Events / Venues – It is an expectation that all club members, guests and Come & Try participants attending non-MX-5 club hosted events / venues will comply with the COVID policy of the host / venue.

Club Run Sign-in Sheets – All club run attendees are required to complete the RSVP response ONLINE, which will facilitate contact tracing if required. Non-completion of the on-line RSVP response, will preclude them from that event.

At commencement of the club run, attendees are not required to sign the club run sign-in sheet. The host will note their attendance.

Club Run Sheets – All run sheets will be provided electronically and it is the responsibility of the attendee to bring their own copy. Copies will **NOT** be provided at the runs.

Come and Try Attendees – Non-financial club members and potential members may attend club runs. Full personal details must be included in the on-line RSVP response. Non-completion of the on-line RSVP response, will preclude them from that club run.
