



Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19) Club Policy Effective 20 July 2020

This Club Policy is effective from 20 July 2020 and replaces the policy in place since 18 March 2020.

This follows from World Health Organisation, Australian Government and SA Government directives and advice. The committee has decided to issue this Club Policy to protect our members when attending Club events.

Australian Government Department of Health directives – It is expected that at Club events, all participants will follow the directives outlined in the following (updated 16 July 2020):

Event participants should take the time to make themselves familiar with the information outlined on this website, which includes but is not limited to the need for good hygiene and social distancing.

It is recommended that all participants bring their own sanitiser, hand wipes and face masks. We are an understanding and inclusive car club and we respect all participants for taking their own personal COVID-19 precautions.

Attendance at Club Events – It is a club member's explicit choice to attend a Club event and they should be fully aware of the health risks from doing so.

Attendance restrictions at Club Events – It is a strict requirement that any Club member or guest **MUST NOT ATTEND** any Club event if they:

- have recently returned from travel overseas, a risk area or a designated hotspot;
- are subject to self-isolation restriction orders; or
- are feeling unwell or showing any symptoms which may indicate Coronavirus, Influenza or a common cold.

Attendance at sporting events – This policy applies equally to Club members and guests attending motorsport events.

Event sign-in sheets – All event attendees are required to complete the RSVP response ON-LINE, which will facilitate contact tracing if required. Non-completion of the on-line RSVP response, will preclude them from that event.

Event run sheets – All run sheets will be provided electronically and it is the responsibility of the attendee to bring their own copy. No copies will be provided at the run.

Come and Try attendees – Non-financial Club members and potential members may attend events only as guests of financial club members. Guests' details must be included in the on-line RSVP response.
